

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (West Hill Road, St Leonards-on-Sea) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

To facilitate access for contractors to carry out essential gas main replacement works, Hastings Borough Council as agent of the East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close parts of the following road:-

Temporary Road Closure

West Hill Road from its junction with Archery Road to its junction with Quarry Hill

The Order will come into force on 30 January 2012 and have a maximum duration of 18 months. However, it is expected that the works will be completed in 3 weeks.

Access to properties will be maintained where possible, but may be restricted at times. Access for pedestrians should not be affected.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be:

For Eastbound traffic via Boscobel Road, Pevensey Road, London Road, Norman Road, Warrior Square, Burton Way, West Ascent and Quarry Hill

For Westbound traffic via Quarry Hill, West Ascent, Gardner Way and West Hill Road
