West St Leonards Neighbourhood Forum and West St Leonards Neighbourhood Area was designated on 6th April 2023. The Forum has since decided they wish to revise the Neighbourhood Area to extend the boundary to include additional parts of Maze Hill ward (including Collinswood Drive). The proposed revision to the Neighbourhood Area boundary also requires a change to the West St Leonards Neighbourhood Forum constitution.

New applications for both the revised West St Leonards Neighbourhood Area and West St Leonards Neighbourhood Forum have been submitted.
