

Response to the East Sussex County Council Supplementary Note (rep 2144/2) for Matter 6 from
Representor 0341/3 - Mrs P. Brown

Dear Lynette,

Kindly pass on to the Inspector my brief comments which are that, 'Having read the latest communication from ESCC Highways, and in particular paras 4.6 and especially 4.8., which states that the planned developments on the Ridge will not produce an increase in traffic sufficient to need highway works to accommodate them, I have to accept their forecast.

Therefore I have no request for you to call for highway works to accompany planning permission for the Ridge development sites in the new Local Plan.

I believe that it will be up to those in a position to do so in due course, to call on the Highway Authority to respond to the 'inevitable' consequences of the extra traffic resulting from planned development on the Ridge.. When this materialises and the significant effect on the Ridge traffic flow is obvious, it will be for those who actually see the effect of the extra traffic to call for the action which E.S. Highways are today forecasting will not be necessary ! .
