

BOROUGH OF HASTINGS

SKATEBOARDING BYELAWS

Byelaws made by the Hastings Borough Council under Section 83 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act 1907 in respect of promenades and under Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and Government of the remainder of the Borough of Hastings and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

EXTENT OF BYELAWS

1. These byelaws shall extend to the whole area of the Borough of Hastings except for those areas defined in the Schedule below.

RESTRICTIONS OF SKATEBOARDING

2. No person shall on the Promenade or any footway or carriageway, skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances to the danger of ~~the~~ other persons using the footway or carriageway.

PENALTY

3. Any person offending against ^{byelaw 2} ~~this byelaw~~ shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE

1. The Front Line including the Upper and Lower Promenades between what was the Western Side of the entrance to the former New Palace Pier and the Eastern end of Denmark Place as lies to the South or Seaward Side, of the carriageway.

as to the user of certain parades or promenades and for the prevention of nuisances, made by the Council of the County Borough of Hastings in pursuance of Section 198 of the Hastings Improvement Act, 1885 and Section 249 of the Local Government Act, 1933, at a meeting of the Council held on the 11th day of July, 1939.



1. In so far as the Council may indicate by notices conspicuously displayed on the Parade described in this Schedule that roller skating is prohibited, no person shall rink or skate on rollers, wheels or other mechanical contrivances upon such Parade.

2. Any person offending against this Byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £5.

THE SCHEDULE.

So much of the Front Line including the Upper and Lower Promenades between the western side of the entrance to the New Palace Pier and the eastern end of Denmark Place as lies to the south, or seaward side, of the carriageway.
