REFERRED MATTERS

236. PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION SUB-COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDED - That Minutes Nos. 23 and 24 of the meeting of the Parking & Transportation Sub-Committee held on 2nd November 1987 and set out in a Schedule appended to these Minutes be approved and adopted subject to the following amendments:-

- (i) Recommendation (i) of Minute No. 24 be amended by the amendment of the last word "Order" to "Orders" and the addition of the following words, "and make the Orders if no objections are received".
- (ii) Recommendation (ii) of Minute No. 24 be amended by the deletion of the words "pay and display" on the last line and insertion of the word "public" in their place together with the addition of the following words, "excluding barrier controlled car parks".

237. HARBOUR ARM SHINGLE REMOVAL

The Borough Engineer & Surveyor reported that four tenders were invited for the removal of shingle at the Fishing Stade adjacent to the Harbour Arm. Details of the Tenders returned were as follows:-

Tender No. 1 (L) - £16,260.00

Tender No. 2 - £18,300.00.

One firm failed to return a tender and a second was received after the stated time for return and remained unopened.

Standing Order 37(3)(d) applied.

Both tenders had been checked and no errors found. A sum of £13,410 was included in the current year's revenue budget for rectifying beach movement. The tender allowed for adjustments to the quantity of shingle to be removed without penalty and a limit of approximately £13,000 would be put on the expenditure to reflect the budget figure.

RECOMMENDED - That:-

- (i) Tender No. 1 (the lowest) submitted by F. Avann Ltd. be accepted in the sum of £16,260.00 for the removal of shingle at the Fishing Stade adjacent to the Harbour Arm subject to adjustments to the quantity of shingle to be removed thus limiting expenditure to approximately £13,000.
- (ii) The Borough Secretary be authorised to complete the necessary documents.
