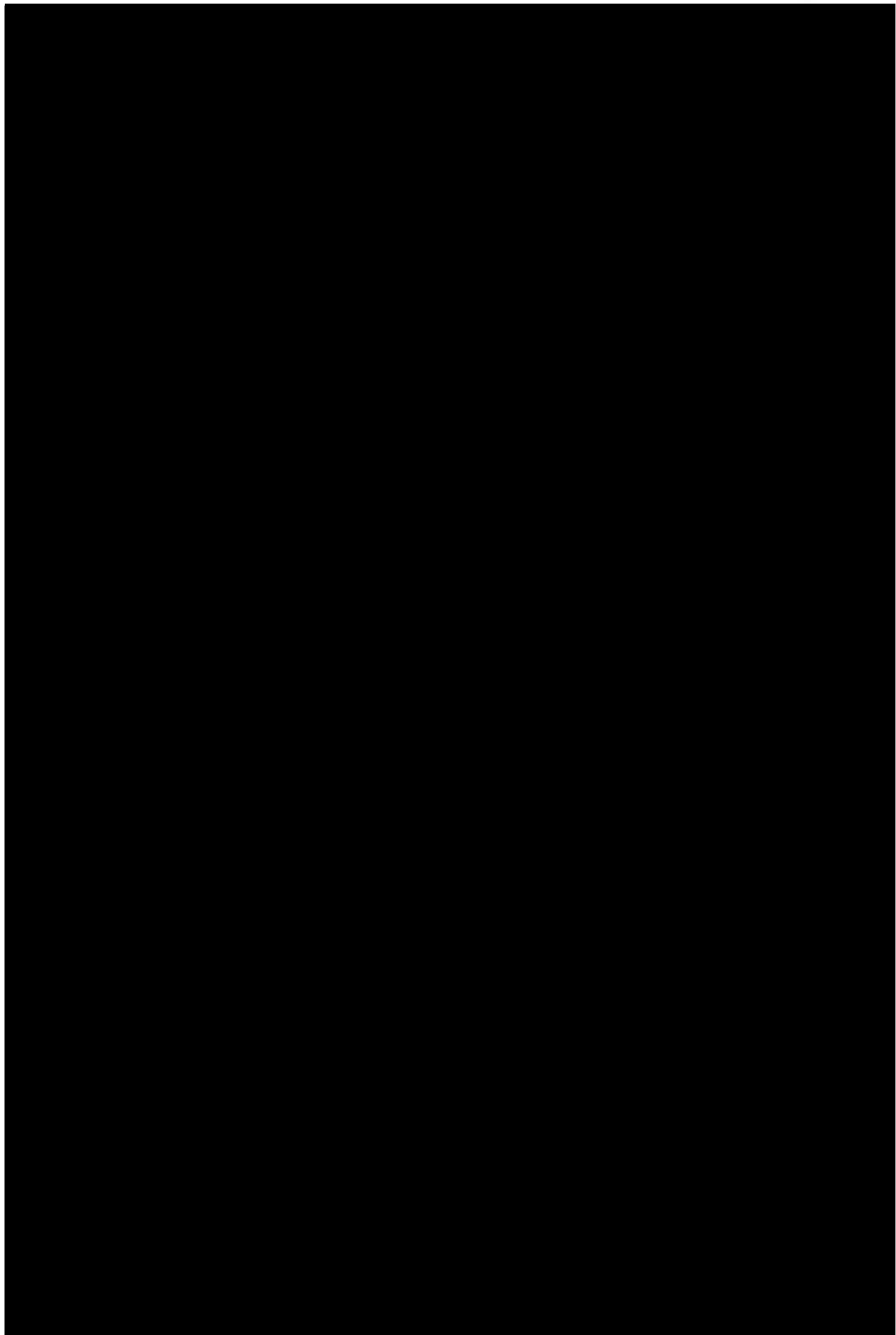

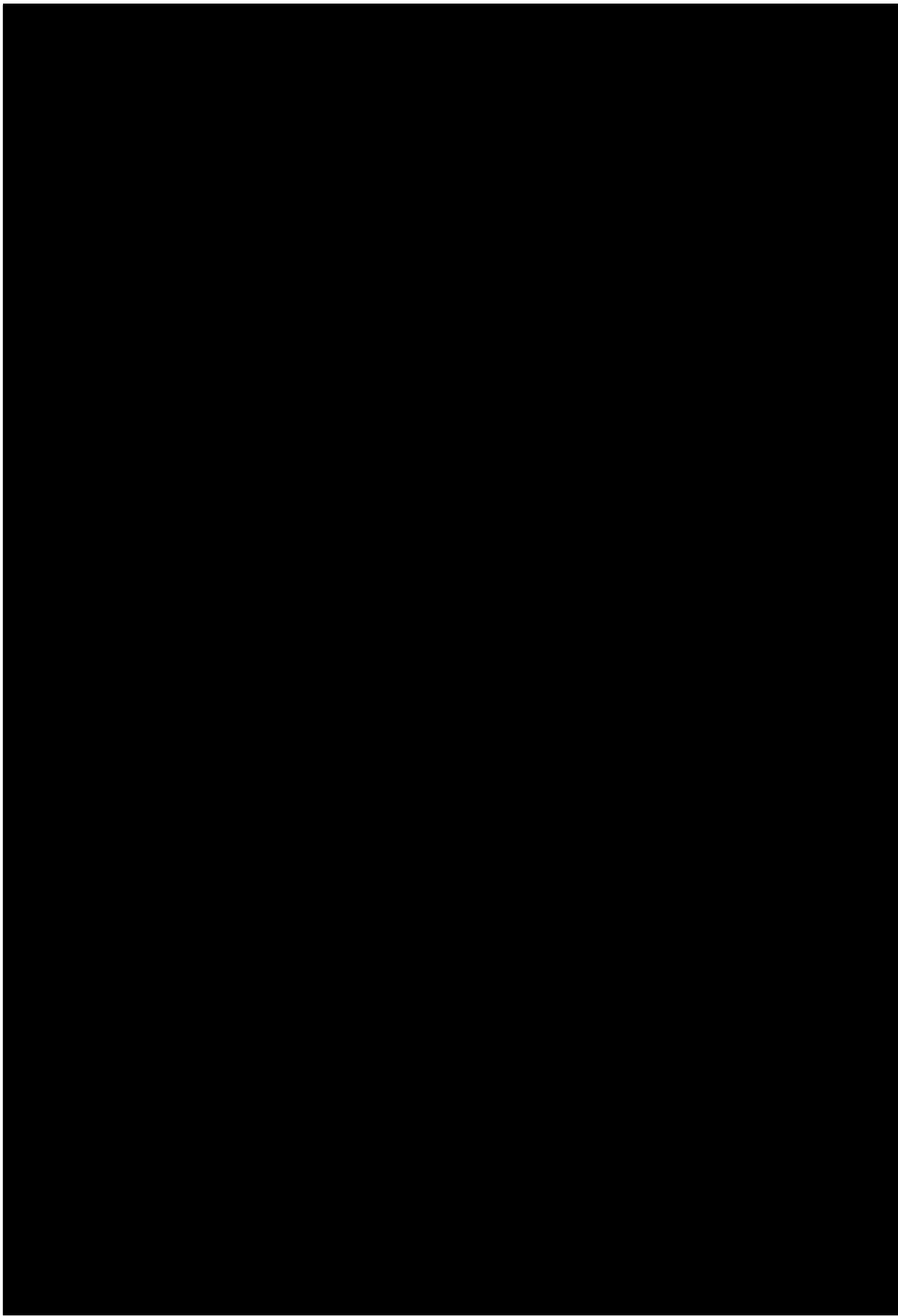

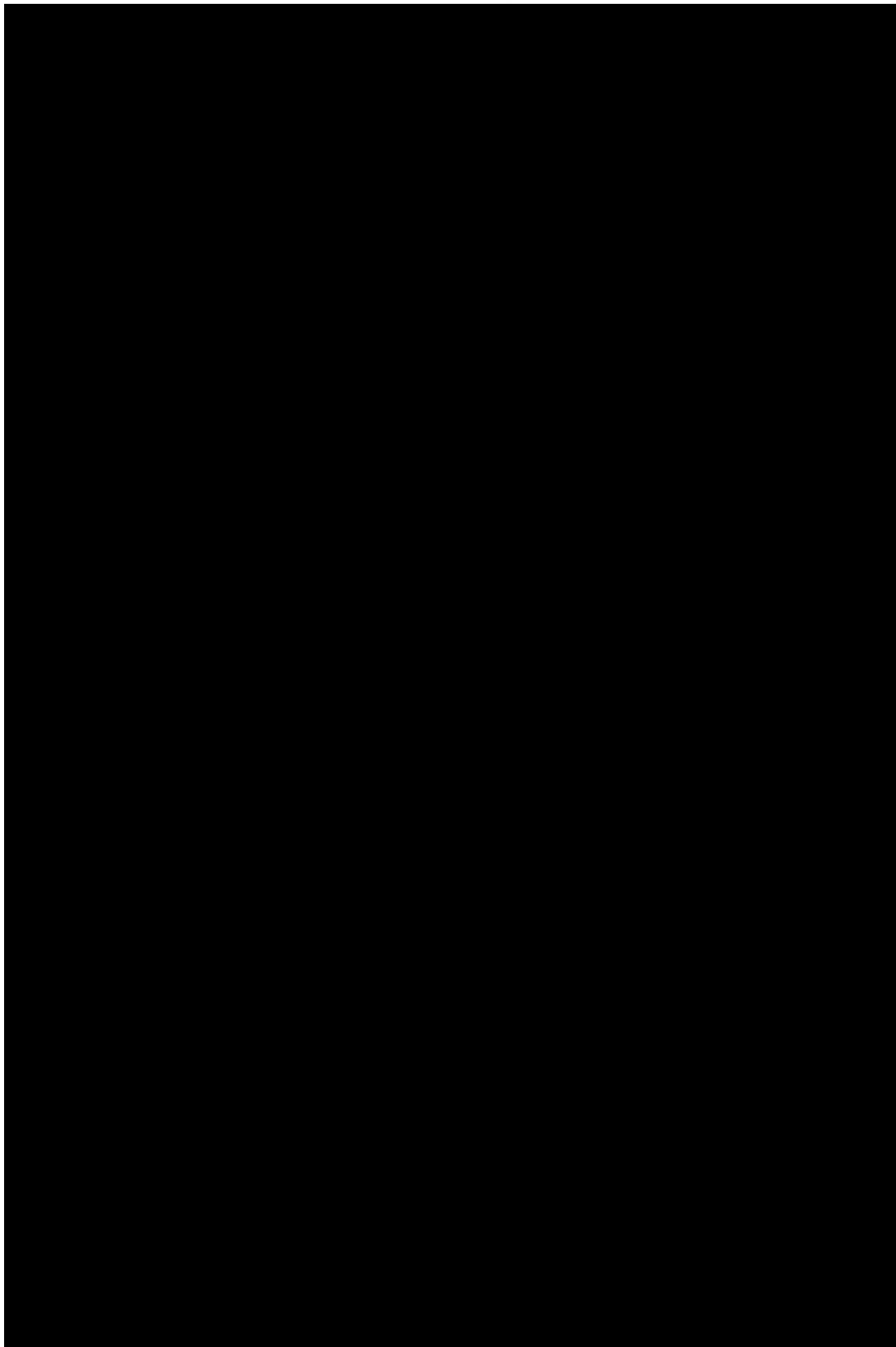

On a related note and further to our exchange back in July, I've given the task of signposting the diversion of the Saxon Shore Way to one of our Ranger teams. Its possible that they might look to start on the job tomorrow, but more likely next week. Can we have a contact for an on-duty Ranger to arrange access ?

I think they'll need access to East Hill from Rocklands lane and access from Barley lane at Fishponds to get up on to the east side of the glen. I suspect access from Barley Lane car park might also make things a bit easier if possible.

We eventually located roughly 50-70 of the current metal discs (as attached), so we'd be looking to attach those with a directional arrow to each of the posts. You mentioned having a small number of the SSW discs to renew other posts in the park. Would a dozen do ?

Where we're following the PRoW we'd be intending use ordinary footpath waymarkers for the direction. Where it follows the informal Country Park paths we were thinking we use permissive path discs (again attached). Are you happy with that approach ?

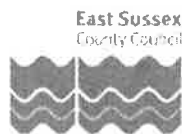

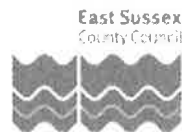

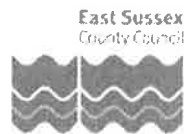
